## Vehicle Loss Assessing Ver 1 – 181119



The IAME is a Registered Training Organisation (RTO 90409) and conducts Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) assessment process for AUR 40514 – Certificate IV in Vehicle Loss Assessing nationally.

If you are involved in the automotive body repair industry and undertake or conduct vehicle loss assessments, have a trade qualification or are an experienced person currently working in the trade and want to become involved in undertaking or conducting vehicle loss assessing, the RPL assessment process allows you to gain recognition for knowledge and skills that you have already acquired through previous studies, informal courses, your work history, or are able to demonstrate.

Once you have provided sufficient evidence and been assessed, candidates will be issued with a Statement of Attainment in those units where sufficient evidence is able to determine competence. If sufficient and appropriate units are achieved according to the packaging rule, a qualification will be issued.
